Week Beginning 26.2.24 Our Topic is... The World Around Us

Next week, we will be learning about...

Topic: On Monday, we have an 'eggciting' arrival... an incubator of eggs will be delivered! Over the next few weeks, we will watch first as the eggs hatch into chicks and then observe the chicks' growth and development. We will make predictions about which eggs will hatch first, weigh both the eggs and the chicks once they hatch and learn facts about the life cycle of the chicken. We will also create chick themed crafts and all have the opportunity to hold and stroke the chicks! Please continue to send in any cardboard boxes, cardboard tubes etc. as we will need lots for our chick themed crafts! Thank you

Phonics: We will be consolidating our learning in Phonics this week. We will be reviewing **er** and **air** and reading words with double letters and practising longer words using our "chunk it up" method!

Maths: We will be learning about money. We will introduce children to the coins: 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p. Children will learn to recognise the coin and how we can use the coins to pay for items up to 10p. We will also introduce the children to our new 'Snack Shop' where they will pay for their snack each day.

How you could help your child:

- Keep practising the Phase 3 phonemes that have been sent home this half term, including
 practising writing them in the phonics home learning book. You could write some words
 with these digraphs and trigraphs in to see if your child can read them. E.g. soap, born,
 chair, hear, night, dark, curl, church, digger, food, look.
- Enjoy reading your child's choice book and decodable book with them over the weekend.

- Reading Books: Please return your child's reading book and the plastic wallet on Monday. The plastic wallet is to keep the books safe on their journey to and from your home
