







| New chord Am(extension chord F) Play tuned instruments musically Use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs Learn the chord Am | |
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Vocabulary ukulele A small guitar-like stringed instrument with 4 nylon strings Rest stroke picking A picking style where the finger or thumb plucks a string and ends up resting directly on the next string. Chord More than one note sounding at the same time Open chord a chord that includes one or more strings that are not fingered. a way of playing a stringed instrument such as a guitar or ukulele; a sweeping action where a finger brushes over Strum several strings to generate sound.


