What is printing?	Who is Karen Lederer?
<ul> <li>Printing is when you transfer a pattern or picture using materials such as paint or ink.</li> <li>Printing makes a copy of something.</li> <li>Some types of printing have been used for thousands of years.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Artwork is fauvist style.</li> <li>Practise drawing a pattern onto paper.</li> <li>Transfer the pattern onto foam by drawing with a felt pen on the Styrofoam.</li> <li>Use a pencil to press into the foam (engrave) to create a groove.</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Print an under the ocean scene using engraving and relief printing methods.</li> <li>Experiment with different amounts and colours of paint.</li> <li>Make a relief printing block of plants and the sea floor.</li> <li>Use foam, card or string to build your relief image.</li> <li>Use bright colours like Lederer.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Print your relief design on top of your sea creature image.</li> <li>Use different colours and re-print the design on top of the sea creature images.</li> </ul>

Vocabulary	
Groove	A narrow cut in a firm material.
Engraving	Cutting a design into a firm material to make a print.
Relief	Building up a design so it stands out on a firm material to make a print.
Fauvist style	A style of art that uses bright colours and bold lines more than realistic likeness.
