Key Knowledge

What is printing?	Who is Karen Lederer?
<ul style="list-style-type: none">Printing is when you transfer a pattern or picture using materials such as paint or ink.Printing makes a copy of something.Some types of printing have been used for thousands of years.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Artwork is fauvist style.Practise drawing a pattern onto paper.Transfer the pattern onto foam by drawing with a felt pen on the Styrofoam.Use a pencil to press into the foam (engrave) to create a groove.
How can I make my own printing picture?	How can I make my own printing picture?
<ul style="list-style-type: none">Print an under the ocean scene using engraving and relief printing methods.Experiment with different amounts and colours of paint.Make a relief printing block of plants and the sea floor.Use foam, card or string to build your relief image.Use bright colours like Lederer.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Print your relief design on top of your sea creature image.Use different colours and re-print the design on top of the sea creature images.

Vocabulary

Groove	A narrow cut in a firm material.
Engraving	Cutting a design into a firm material to make a print.
Relief	Building up a design so it stands out on a firm material to make a print.
Fauvist style	A style of art that uses bright colours and bold lines more than realistic likeness.
