In **Maths** next week, we will continue to look at improving the children's fluency in the 4 and 8 timetable and learning how to multiply 3 one-digit numbers and looking at factor pairs.

e.g.

The factors of 36: 1,2,3,4,6,9,12,18,36

The factor pairs of 36: (1x36), (2x18), (3x12), (4x9) (6x6)

In **English** we will be looking at poetry and looking at imagery.

In **Spelling** we will be learning how to use possessive apostrophises with plurals.

e.g.

The dog's kennel

The dogs' kennel

In **History** we will be looking at who Henry VII and his six wives were.
