Structure of the Governing Body

The school is a community school and it reconstituted in line with statutory guidelines on 1st November 2015.

There are 14 FGB Governors appointed:

- 4 elected Parent Governors
- 1 Head Teacher
- 1 Staff Governor
- 7 co-opted Governors
- 1 Local Authority Governor.

The term of office of FGB governors (other than the Head Teacher) is 4 years.

The instrument of government came into effect on 1st September 2015.

The Governing Body has established committees to which it delegates responsibilities for various aspects of the running of the school: the Children's Committee, the Resources Committee, the Head Teachers Performance Management Committee, and the Pay Committee.
